



**Job Title:** Electrician (IBEW Union #481)

**POSITION SUMMARY:** This position has the responsibility of assisting in the maintenance of electrical operations for the entire Stadium and Convention Center complex. Accountability is to the Facility Manager.

**DUTIES:**

- Maintain/repair Stadium and Convention Center electrical needs.
- Install and dismantle electrical hook-ups for trade shows, meetings and sports events.
- Install lighting schedule into Metasys and/or Lutron for Convention Center.
- Install lighting schedule into Lutron computer system for control during Stadium events.
- Extract electrical requirements from show documents and coordinate additional information from Event Coordinators, Facility Management Staff, and Show Management Staff.
- Communicate event billing information to Facility Management Staff.
- Perform preventative maintenance inside and outside the facility which may include high work.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Must have the ability to work with efficiency and composure under stressful conditions and have the ability to interact positively with the public, clients, and co-workers. Must be able to work fluctuating hours including evenings and weekends.

**EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:**

Ten years experience in commercial and industrial electrical industry, to include 5 years and 8000 hours on the job training in a JATC apprentice program, plus additional training in motor control, and National Electric Code requirements.

**MATHEMATICAL SKILLS:**

Ability to work with mathematical concepts. Ability to extract information from electrical and process control diagrams. Ability to apply concepts such as fractions, percentages, ratios, and proportions to practical situations.
